IPP began its activity in 1985 as a result of the 1979 redefinition of the national education strategy which created polytechnic institutions.

1985: School of Education (ESE) and the School of Music (ESMAE);

1988: School of Accounting and Management (ISCAP);

1989: School of Engineering (ISEP);

1990: School of Management and Industrial Studies (ESEIG);

1994: School of Management and Technology of Felgueiras

(ESTGF);

2006: School on Allied Health Sciences (ESTSP)



- IPP elaborated and approved its Statutes in 1995, where were defined the mission and goals for the institution.
- In **2006**, made the first alteration in the Statutes.
- In **2009** publish a new IPP's Statutes in compliance with the new Legal framework for the evaluation of higher education.
